First Baptist Family,

As I've mentioned to you before, I typically wait until February to share with you how we finished the previous financial year. By waiting a month, it gives Terri time to finish all the end-of-the-year financial work she has to do. And since people can make donations as long as they are postmarked by 12/31, it can take a few days for everything to come in and for Terri to finish her work. Those few days, of course, are after our First Word deadline – hence sharing all of this with you in February. Happily, I have good news to share! Our budget for 2024 was \$464,387. Now, because of several unexpected and costly repairs (primarily to HVAC units), our expenses for 2024 were \$480,558.29. Yet our total revenue for the year was \$482,575.94, allowing us to finish 2024 in the black by \$2,017.65. Thank you for your continued faithfulness in giving! And thank you for your continued presence in the life and the work of the church! As you hear me say regularly, good things are happening here at First Baptist Bristol – good things worth inviting others to, good things worth celebrating. I believe that your faithful giving is but another testimony to the ways at which God is at work in and through this church! And since God is blessing us as a congregation, we are called to continue in the good work we have started.

One of the people who has helped lead us in this good work is our Minister of Music, Rev. Leigh Clark. With the hustle and bustle of December, I failed to mention that Leigh celebrated her 5-year anniversary with us then as our Minister of Music. As those who serve in our Music Ministry can attest, Leigh is not only an exceptionally talented musician, but she's an even better person, minister, and friend! We are incredibly fortunate to have her on staff. Truthfully, we have been blessed as a church when it comes to all of our church staff. We've had high degree of staff stability, which has become increasingly rare in churches, and that stability has allowed us to grow closer together and work better together to expand our efforts for God's Kingdom. In fact, our most recent hire is Niki, our Administrative Assistant, who will be celebrating her 4-year anniversary with us later this month.

And Emma Vance, who has been involved in this church for years and has been working with our children for the last few years, is now attending seminary to further her theological education. All of these are incredibly good things that we need to celebrate as a church! So, I encourage you to share your words of encouragement with our staff when you get the chance.

As for February, there are a few events and activities that are taking place this month that I want to mention. While things will really get going in March with the start of Lent, we still have a few things in February I want to make sure that you know about. First, on Sunday, February 2, we'll have our monthly Family Breakfast before Sunday School and then later that day in worship we will take communion. During the month of February, I'm going to be working my way through our sermon series "The Mission of Jesus", so I hope that you'll continue to join us for that. And then on Friday, February 21-Sunday, February 23, our Youth will have a mini retreat. They'll be going back to Wafloy, near Gatlinburg, where they've had several retreats recently. I ask that you continue to be in prayer for them. Despite the bitterly cold weather we've had in January, we are off to a good start in 2025, so continue to look for ways to be involved in the life of the church and continue to bring some new people with you. Both they and you will be blessed if you do.

Notes... from Leigh


