February 2024

First Baptist Family,

Typically, in February I share with you how we finished the previous financial year. Now, I wait until February because there's all sorts of end-of-the-year financial work that Terri has to finish. Since people can make donations as long as they are postmarked by 12/31, it can take a few days for everything to come in and for Terri to finish her work, and those few days are after our First Word deadline. So, in keeping with my tradition, I want to update you now, and I have good news to share. Before I do, though, I want to remind you of something. We increased our budget significantly in 2023, in large part because of how well we did in 2022. 2022 was the best giving year we have had in quite some time. If you'll remember, our giving exceeded our budget by \$9,385.03 in 2022, so we challenged ourselves as a congregation in 2023. And I'm happy to report that all of you stepped up in a big way! After being behind budget for most of the year, we had a fantastic giving month in December. It was one of the best giving months we've had in a long time. Our budget for 2023 was \$495,000 and we took in \$488,640 for the year. We only came up \$6,360 or 1.28% short of meeting our budget, which given where we were at the start of December is remarkable! We followed up 2022, one of the best giving years we've had in recent memory, by taking in roughly \$20,000 more in 2023! Thank you for your faithfulness in giving! And thank you for your continued presence in the life and work of the church! Good things are happening here at First Baptist Bristol - things worth inviting others to, things worth celebrating. I believe this is a testimony to the way God is at work in and through this church! God is blessing us as a congregation, and we are called to keep up the good work we've started.

Thankfully, February is going to be a month in which we can keep that good work going. There are lots of things we have scheduled for this month, and I can assure you – they are going to be things you will want to be here for. First, on Saturday, February 3, we're going to host the community MLK event at 2 PM in the sanctuary. If you'll remember, we were supposed to have that event on January 15, but the weather forced us to postpone it. The program and the guest speaker, Tybre Faw, will remain the same, however. I hope that you'll be able to join us for what should be a wonderful event. Then, on Sunday, February 4, our very own Rev. Leigh Clark will be preaching. Every year in either February or March, we celebrate what Baptist Women in Ministry (BWIM) used to call Martha Stearns Marshall Preaching Month. The event celebrates the ministerial giftedness of women, which is something we've been doing as a congregation for 70 years! I know that you'll want to be here that Sunday to support and encourage Leigh. Then, on Sunday, February 11, we'll take up our annual Souper Bowl of Caring offering at the end of worship. This offering, collected by our youth, goes towards helping the benevolence requests of people in this community. February is also the start of Lent. On Tuesday, February 13, we'll celebrate Fat Tuesday or Shrove Tuesday. Rather than our traditional pancake supper, however, we're going to be having a Seafood Boil! Please sign up with Niki in the church office to ensure that we have enough seafood and King Cake for everyone. Dinner will be at 6 PM While there is no set cost for the meal, we are asking people to make a donation. All proceeds will go towards local missions. Then, on Wednesday, February 14 at 6 PM, we'll have our Ash Wednesday service in the chapel. This will be a solemn, powerful service that you will want to attend. Please remember that we will not be having our regular Wednesday night meal that evening.

During the latter part of February and early part of March, we're also going to be doing something new. Clary and I will be leading a Marriage Enrichment Study. We'll be leading a study on The Five Love Languages by Gary Chapman. We'll meet in Rosser Hall from 3:00-4:30 PM on the following Sundays: February 18, February 25, March 3, and March 10. The deadline to sign up will be Wednesday, February 14. Childcare will also be provided. If you'd like a copy of the book, let Niki know when you sign up. The cost of the book is \$13.90. Please invite your friends to this, and if you have married adult children, let them know about this study, too. We'd love for them to join us because stronger marriages and healthier families help people, whether they're members of this church or not.

Celebrating the ministerial giftedness of women, worshiping together, fellowshipping together, collecting money for local benevolence and missions, having studies to help strengthen marriages, all of that makes for a good, full month. They also help people become more healthy, holy, and whole, too, and that's our goal for this year. So, join us this month and invite others to join you. I know that you and they will be glad that you did.


