First Baptist Family,

March promises to be a full month in the life of the church! Consequently, I'd like to highlight several things happening this month. First, on Sunday, March 2, we'll have Family Breakfast before Sunday School and then later that day in worship we will take communion together. On Tuesday, March 4 at 6 PM, we'll have our annual Fat Tuesday/Shrove Tuesday celebration. Rather than pancakes, however, we're going to have a seafood boil! Don't worry, though, we'll still have King Cake. This is always a popular event, so I want to encourage you to please sign up in the church office. We want to make sure that we have enough food for everyone. Then, the very next day, we'll have our Ash Wednesday service in JoAnn Feazell Chapel, also at 6 PM. Please note that we will NOT have a Wednesday Night Meal on Wednesday, March 5. The youth and the choir will meet like normal after our service, though. Our Ash Wednesday service is always solemnly powerful, so I know that you will want to be here for it, even if you don't normally come on Wednesday nights.

Since Sunday, March 9 marks the first Sunday in Lent, I'm going to be starting a new sermon series entitled "The Promises of Lent." Since Lent is a season that focuses on frailty, sinfulness, and our need for repentance, those are largely going to be the themes in the sermons. Still, Lent also reminds us that we are part of something bigger than ourselves and that God can do amazing things with dust. That's why the series and this season are going to have hopeful notes to them as well.

On Sunday, March 23, we're going to be joined in worship by our friend, Jessica Hearne. As I'm sure you remember, Jessica is a CBF missionary serving in Danville, Virginia. Jessica will preach in worship that Sunday while also updating us on the good work that she's doing in Danville, particularly as she seeks to build community while addressing housing and food insecurity. Then, finally, Sunday, March 30 also promises to be a busy day. Our very own Rev. Leigh Clark will be preaching as we join in with Baptist Women in Ministry (BWIM) and celebrate the ministerial giftedness of women.

I'm sure Leigh will share a few updates of her and Mark's trip to Germany, too! Then, after worship, our Youth will have their annual fundraiser. They'll be having their annual Spaghetti Luncheon and Cake Auction. While the event is to raise money for youth missions, it always provides a good time. There will be good food, even better fellowship, and the opportunity to bid on and buy some absolutely beautiful desserts – with all of the money going to a good cause, of course! Consequently, you don't want to miss it.

You hear me say regularly that good things are happening at First Baptist Bristol, and what we have planned for this month is proof of that. That's why I want to encourage you to be present for as many of these events as you can. Bring some people with you, too. 
